POSITION PURPOSE

The position is responsible for directing, controlling and coordinating the work of Policy Research and Development and providing Executive Management with analysis, policy, advice, resource mobilisation recommendations and support on all research, innovation and development activities related to the Ministry for Waterways and Environment.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The position will achieve its purpose through the following key duties. Working with relevant management and staff, in accordance with Guidelines, policies and legislative requirements, meeting the operational needs of the Ministry:

- 1. Provision of quality advice to the Minister/Permanent Secretary and Management team in terms of the Ministry related deliverables:
- 2. Provide high level research advice, proposals (resource mobilization) and expertise to key internal and external stakeholders to better inform policy development and implementation;
- 3. Defines, collect analysis and report useful information to enhance decision making and program involvement;
- 4. Constructively contribute to the formulation, implementation and evaluation of National Waterways/Environment Policy and Plans;
- 5. Oversee the Coordination and implementation of special projects and programs assigned for the Ministry.
- 6. Provide leadership and coordination of the policy development, research and development division to ensure that the division's core deliverables are achieved in line with the Division's Business Plan and Ministry's Operational Plan;
- 7. Coordinate the quarterly report of the Division capturing all deliverables of the Division for Management's information and decision.

- 8. Provide guidance through coaching and mentoring and develop subordinate officers throughtraining to enhance performance and teamwork for the timely achievement of their deliverables;
- 9. Monitor the conduct of performance assessment at individual and divisional level to gauge work progress in line with the agreed targets in the various plans;
- 10. Actively contribute and lead all corporate requirements of the Ministry including planning, budgeting and selection activates where required and instructed.

- 5. Good understanding of the global, regional and national waterways/environment work and issues at a strategic level
- 6. Understanding of the Fijian Constitution (2013) and applicable laws of Fiji.
