### MINISTRY OF WATERWAYS

#### EMERGENCY RIVERS/CREEKS DESILTING and DREDGING WORKS FOR FLOOD MITIGATION PURPOSE

The Ministry of Waterways in its stand to address the growing threat of flooding of the existing waterways in Fiji is collaborating with the Ministry of Environment and the Ministry of Lands & Mineral Resources on the new activity of desilting and dredging of major rivers and creeks that are heavily silted. The EOI expressed by the competent companies will work in collaboration with the Ministry to implement the desilting/dredging works under the **'Public Private Partnership Agreement'** at **'No cost to Government'** basis and on the understanding that the company will take away the desilted or dredged materials.

The following creeks and rivers have been identified in the three respective divisions, Central, Western and Northern Division for emergency desilting or dredging works:


