





The Application Process


Community Groups (five or more) are invited to collect application forms from any of the following Ministries divisional offices, websites, or Facebook pages

- Ministry of Environment
- Ministry of Economy
- iTaukei Affairs Board
- Ministry of Women, Children and Poverty Alleviation; and
- Ministry of Youth and Sports
- Ministry of Rural and Maritime Development

Requirements for Assessment

O1. Identification cards include vaccination card and any of the following: voter cards, copy of birth certificates, Joint card (FNPF/Tin).

Approval of Proposals

- Group proposals will be approved provided the proposals meet the project categories
- Successful beneficiaries will be contacted either through written correspondence or telephone.
- Successful beneficiaries will then be required to provide details of their Bank Account and FNPF account and tin number (if not available, these will need to be set up accordingly)
- Payment of Wages will be dispersed in trenches upon completion of stages of work.
