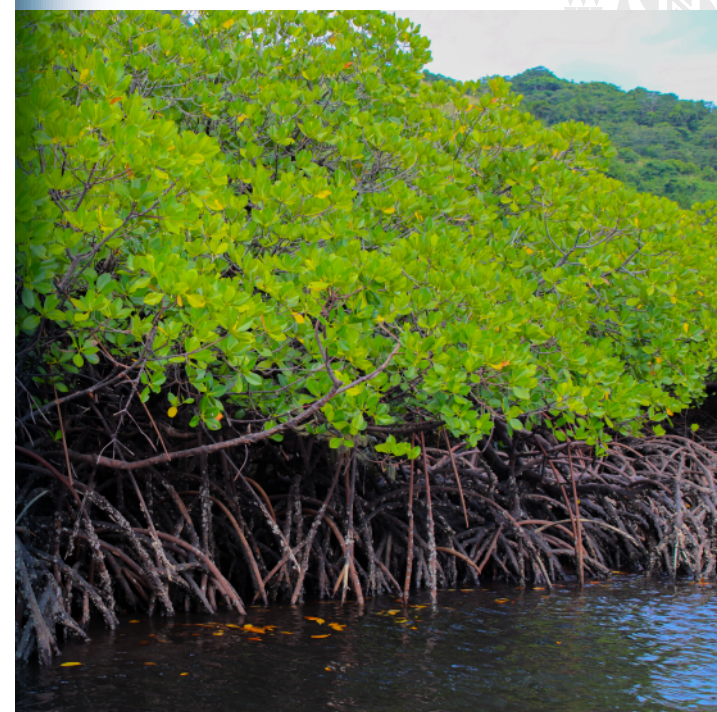

INTRODUCTION

Jobs for Nature 2.0 (JFN2)

JFN2 is a World Bank funded project that will support job opportunities through small-scale projects for vulnerable Fijians residing in rural areas



Registered community groups are welcome to apply for example Village cooperatives, Women's groups, and Youth groups.

The Application Process

Community Groups (five or more) are invited to collect application forms from any of the following Ministries divisional offices, websites, or Facebook pages

- Ministry of Environment
- Ministry of Economy
- iTaukei Affairs Board
- Ministry of Women, Children and Poverty Alleviation; and
- Ministry of Youth and Sports
- Ministry of Rural and Maritime Development



Requirements for Assessment

- 01.** Identification cards include vaccination card and any of the following: voter cards, copy of birth certificates, Joint card (FNPF/Tin).



- 02.** Application Form (includes proposal)

Apply for small scale projects under the following categories:



- Wetlands protection: example: mangrove planting,



- Riverbank rehabilitation and coastal bank protection: example mangrove planting, vetiver grass planting.



- Enhancing biodiversity: example forest restoration, native tree planting, coral reef protection.



- Waste and wastewater management.

Approval of Proposals

- Group proposals will be approved provided the proposals meet the project categories
- Successful beneficiaries will be contacted either through written correspondence or telephone.
- Successful beneficiaries will then be required to provide details of their Bank Account and FNPF account and tin number (if not available, these will need to be set up accordingly)
- Payment of Wages will be dispersed in trenches upon completion of stages of work.
